

JJCC CBO Member(s)

JJCC approved the application process for CBOs. They asked the ad hoc committee to develop a recruitment process to be presented at the 10/9 JJCC meeting. The ad hoc committee met 9/30. The recommendation for recruitment will be to utilize VCPAs, BH and HSA list of vendors that are notified for RFPs and RFIs; to ask the YES collaborative to communicate with the CBOs that they work with; and through VCPA's social media.

The following should be the message included in the recruitment:

The Ventura County Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council's (JJCC) purpose shall be to develop and implement a continuum of county-based responses to juvenile delinquency and to set priorities for the use of Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA) grant funds and to develop a comprehensive multi-agency plan that identifies resources and strategies for providing an effective continuum of responses for the prevention, intervention, supervision, treatment, and incarceration of youthful offenders, including strategies to develop and implement local out-of-home residential options.

Pursuant to 749.22 WIC and Ventura County JJCC by-laws, the JJCC is recruiting a community-based organization that is involved in juvenile crime prevention to be selected through an application process and appointed by the permanent members of the Council. In making these appointments, the Council shall strive to ensure both geographical representation and a diversity of perspectives to fulfill the purpose of the Council.
