Pursuant to 749.22 WIC and Ventura County JJCC by-laws, one community-based organization involved in juvenile crime prevention will have a representative on the JJCC. The by-laws allow for a maximum of two additional CBOs to be on the council.

At JJCC's request an ad hoc subcommittee was formed to develop and recommend an application process for CBOs. Said recommendation is as follows:

On behalf of the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council (JJCC), Probation will host the application on their website. The application will include notification that an interview may be conducted. The applications will be reviewed by an ad hoc subcommittee which will make recommendations to the JJCC.

The application will consist of the following questions:

- 1. What area(s) of Ventura County does your organization serve?
- 2. Briefly tell us about your organization, its mission and applicable work in juvenile crime prevention in Ventura County.
- 3. What is your familiarity with JJCC?
- 4. Please tell us why your organization would like to be a member of the JJCC and why you feel your organization is well suited to this role.
- 5. Tell us about one or two specific things that your organization has done to promote diversity, equity and/or inclusion related to juvenile crime prevention.
