<u>A Journey from Adversity to Purpose, and what makes us credible messengers</u>


Growing up, experiencing Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) led to involvement in gangs and ultimately incarceration in the California Youth Authority (CYA). Those years were a profound turning point—marked by confusion, anger, and a deep sense of being lost in a system that often seemed more focused on punishment than understanding. Yet, even in those dark moments, a seed of resilience was planted—a quiet but growing desire for change. Today, coming full circle to work with at-risk youth is both a privilege and a calling. Drawing from our own experiences, we use the lessons hard-earned through adversity to connect with young people facing similar challenges.




VENTURA COUNTY YOUTH GANG RATES

HISTORICAL TRENDS:

- 4% OF VENTURA COUNTY 11TH-GRADE STUDENTS REPORTED GANG MEMBERSHIP DURING 2017-2019, DOWN FROM 6% IN 2015-2017.
- THIS DECLINE SUGGESTS PROGRESS BUT HIGHLIGHTS THE CONTINUED PRESENCE OF GANG INFLUENCE AMONG YOUTH.

CALL TO ACTION:

- REDUCING YOUTH GANG INVOLVEMENT REQUIRES COMPREHENSIVE STRATEGIES THAT STRENGTHEN FAMILIES, SCHOOLS, AND COMMUNITIES BY ADDRESSING THE PSYCHOLOGICAL, SOCIAL, PHYSICAL, AND ECONOMIC NEEDS OF YOUNG PEOPLE.
- **RECOMMENDED PARTNERSHIPS:**
- ENGAGE WITH LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AND ORGANIZATIONS LIKE THE VENTURA COUNTY PROBATION AGENCY FOR UP-TO-DATE DATA AND COLLABORATIVE INTERVENTION EFFORTS.






BUILD TRUST AND UNDERSTAND AND LOG THE YOUTH'S NEEDS, GOALS, AND CHALLENGES.

EVALUATION, MEASURABLES



- DOMINANT VENUE: THE MAJORITY OF YOUTH ENGAGEMENTS OCCURRED AT THE PROGRAM CENTER, ACCOUNTING FOR APPROXIMATELY 50 VISITS, HIGHLIGHTING ITS CENTRAL ROLE IN FOSTERING COMMUNITY INTERACTION.
- <u>YOUTH ENGAGEMENT</u>: HIGH PARTICIPATION RATES SUGGEST A STRONG INTEREST AND CONSISTENT INVOLVEMENT AMONG YOUTH, SHOWCASING THE PROGRAM'S APPEAL AND EFFECTIVENESS.
- FREQUENT VISITORS: REPEAT PARTICIPANTS WERE IDENTIFIED, INDICATING A SENSE OF LOYALTY AND THE POTENTIAL FOR DEEPER DEVELOPMENTAL IMPACTS ON CONSISTENT ATTENDEES.

Part time Operations Manager and Assistant community outreach (960 hours per year, \$1,792.00 per month) Responsible for day to day program activities and engaging with youth and families including coordinating facility use and activities during business hours.
